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## How to pay you safely

You will need a bank account in your own name to get paid compensation money. This has to be a bank account that is only in your name and that no one else can take money out of.

This is so we can pay your compensation money safely.

Do you have a bank account now that is only in your name and that no one else can take money out of?

If you do not have a bank account that is only in your name and that no one else can take money out of, then we need you to open one. You can get help by filling in the box below.

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## How to send Maurice Blackburn your bank account statement

We need you to send Maurice Blackburn your bank account statement showing:

1. Your full name
2. Bank
3. Account number
4. BSB number  
(This is the branch code for the bank branch you opened your bank account at.)

We do not need to see anything else on your bank account statement (like how much money you have or what you spend your money on).

**We can't pay you compensation money if you do not give us your bank account statement.**

You can send Maurice Blackburn your bank account statement and ID these ways:

### Bank account statement

1. Screenshot, scan or photo of your bank account details - by text message or email; **or**
2. Photo of a computer screen showing your bank account details - by text message or email; **or**
3. Paper bank account statement from your bank or internet banking, this has to be an original print, not a photocopy - by post in the mail.

### Copies of ID




1. Photo or scan of your ID - by text message or email; **or**
2. Photocopy of your ID - by post in the mail.
