

CASH CONVERTERS NSW CLASS ACTIONS NOTICE OF SETTLEMENT

Two Federal Court class actions against Cash Converters have been settled in principle. The settlement provides for a refund to be paid to all borrowers of Cash Converters' 'cash advances' and 'personal loans' in New South Wales between 1 July 2010 and 30 June 2013 who paid a fee called a 'Deferred Establishment Fee'. The amount of the refund is likely to be the full amount of that fee, plus 20%, but it may be less and it may be paid in more than one instalment.

The class actions were started in October 2013 by Ms Julie Gray. Her lawyers, Maurice Blackburn, will be appointed the Claims Administrator if the Federal Court approves the settlement.

Maurice Blackburn has been ordered by the Federal Court to tell you that (subject to Court approval):

1. The refund will be paid into your bank account last known to Cash Converters unless you tell Maurice Blackburn within 28 days of receiving this notice that you do not want the refund, or that you want it paid into another bank account;
2. If your bank account does not work Maurice Blackburn may try to find you to identify an alternative bank account, but if that is not successful you will not get the refund;
3. Maurice Blackburn's costs will be paid from the settlement fund and interest earned on it and not by asking you for money; and
4. If there is money left over then it will be refunded to Cash Converters at the end of the settlement process which is 12 months from the establishment of the settlement fund.

If you wish, you can attend the hearing at which the Federal Court will decide whether to approve the settlement. This hearing will take place at 10:15am on 12 October 2015 at the Federal Court of Australia, Queens Square, Sydney NSW 2000. You do not need to attend the hearing to receive a refund.
